 - d. Is the conflict resolved from the Barber's point of view? From Captain Torres' point of view?
- 2. Reread the opening paragraphs of the story and explain how they provide background information about the following:
 - a. Setting
 - b. Character
 - c. Plot
 - d. Conflict
 - e. How do these paragraphs capture the interest of the reader?
